

I, You, We, They & Verbs

Question: Do + subject + verb?

- Do you know the new employee?
- Do we have a meeting later?
- Do they want the report?
- Do I need to ask the boss?

No, (subject) don't.

Yes, (subject) do.

Affirmative: Subject + verb.

- You know the new employee.
- We have a meeting later.
- They want the report.
- I need to ask the boss.

Negative: Subject + don't + verb.

- You don't know the new employee.
- We don't have a meeting later.
- They don't want the report.
- I don't need to ask the boss.

"I love my job at Rubicon. We have a lot of employee benefits. I have unlimited paid vacation days. We also have a gym at the office. Some of my colleagues work from home. They like that policy. We don't have catered lunch or holiday bonuses at Rubicon. I'm happy with the benefits package at Rubicon."
