

# Progress Words

## Still

They are still working on the report.

Use still to talk about a task someone started in the past and is working on currently.

Subject + am/is/are + still + verb+ing + information.

## Just

He just received the files.  
She's just reviewing the report now.

Use just to talk about a recent past action or an action that is happening now.

Subject + just + verb in past + information.

Subject + am/is/are + just + verb+ing + information + now.

## Already

She already sent the email.

Use already to talk about completed tasks or other past actions.

Subject + already + verb in past + information.

## Yet

Did you meet with our client? Not yet!

Use yet in a negative response to a question about progress. Yet suggests that an action will happen in the future.

Talk about the following work tasks using progress words:

- A task you started but that is not finished.
- A task your colleague completed this week.
- A task you completed before class.

- Create a question about progress for your classmate!
