

# Present Perfect Key Words

## Never, Any, Lately, Yet, Ever

### Never

Subject + have/has + never + past participle + information.

#### Examples:

1. She has never worked for a large company.
2. We have never presented at a conference.

### Any + Lately

Subject + have/has not + past participle + any + plural noun + lately  
OR

Have/Has + subject + past participle + any + plural noun + lately?

#### Examples:

1. They haven't been to any conferences lately.
2. Has Tomas hosted any workshops lately?

### Yet

Subject + have/has not + past participle + information + yet.

#### Examples:

1. Sara hasn't completed her training yet.
2. We haven't hired a new intern yet.

### Ever

Have/Has + subject + ever + past participle + information?

#### Examples:

1. Have you ever traveled internationally for work?
2. Has he ever worked in sales?
