Feelings and Emotions

Stress	Love
Happiness	Trust
Sadness	Concern
Anger	Excitement

Remember:

Uncountable nouns are treated like singular nouns when we select a verb.

For example:

There is a lot of noise in the office.
The team's excitement is evident.

Don't add "s"!

Uncountable nouns cannot be plural.

~~We have a lot of informations.~~
We have a lot of information.

Ask about quantity using "much".

Use "how much", not "how many".

~~How many space do we need?~~
How much space do we need?

Use "is", not "are".

Treat an uncountable noun like "it".

~~The equipment are ready.~~
The equipment is ready.
