The Future in the Passive Voice



The Future with Will

Object + will (not) be + past participle + subject.

Examples:

Our eco-friendly products will be manufactured in the UK.

Our products won't be sold until they undergo a strict product safety evaluation.

The Future with Going to

Object + is/are going to be +

past participle + subject.

Examples:

Employees are going to be asked to participate in professional development programs.

IT requests aren't going to be reviewed on Mondays.

Questions in the passive voice

WHAT

What will be expected of employees with these new policies?

WHERE

Where are products going to be delivered?

WHEN

When will staff be required to submit vacation time?

WHY

Why will clients be asked to complete a satisfaction survey?

HOW

How is our work going to be affected by the new changes?
